# **Test Updates**

## **Effective April-May 2023**

Pathology Laboratories, Inc. (PathLabs), in conjunction with our reference laboratory partners, is in the process of making updates to its test menu for various changes as fully described within the contents of this technical bulletin. Although some updates were effective in late April 2023, the majority are set for implementation on Monday, May 15, 2023, as disclosed in the chart provided herein.

#### The test updates include changes for certain tests in the following areas:

- EMR Mapping (including revisions to LOINC codes)
- Reference Ranges
- Revised Result Fields
- Specimen Requirements (New Collection Tube Types)
